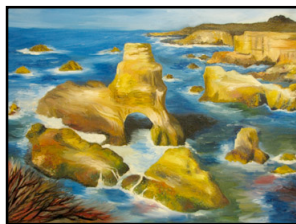
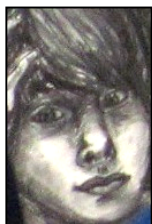

**Location:** Towson Arts Collective, 406 York Rd. (Lower level), Towson, MD 21204

**Eligibility:** Original Artwork in any 2-D medium by a Baltimore City or County student in grades 9-12. **Only one entry per artist will be allowed.**  
HS Artists will enter through their school. Each school is limited to three entries.  
Art must be framed and wired. 40 inches x 40 inches is the maximum size.  
Each piece must have a 3 x 5 label attached. (See "Registration" below.)

**Awards:** Three \$100 prizes will be awarded:  
Best painting (any painting medium, including mixed media)  
Best photograph (digital or traditional photography)  
Best drawing (any drawing medium including handmade prints and graphic design)  
In addition, three Honorable Mention winners will receive gift certificates.
